



Connect To Care at Your Child's School!

What is the school telehealth clinic?

Is it possible for your child to have a visit with a medical provider without leaving school? *YES!* A telehealth visit now makes it possible for your child to be seen at school by a provider for minor illnesses such as:



Who can use the school telehealth clinic?

Any student can connect to care if their parent or guardian signs the enrollment and consent form. Consent is also required at the time of each telehealth visit.

Why are we offering this service?

By putting a telehealth clinic in your school, we can provide students with the care they need while allowing them to stay at school, if possible. You will be able to get healthcare for your child without taking time from work or home duties.

How does it work?

When your child has a minor injury or is not feeling well at school, these injuries and symptoms can often be treated by common over-the-counter medications that would produce immediate results and could allow your child to remain in school. At the school telehealth clinic, you will be called when your child may need this service. The medical provider for these visits is offsite and connected to the exam with audio-visual technology. A trained clinical professional will be with your child and will show the provider the child's ears, throat, and nose and allow the provider to remotely listen to heart and lung sounds and even use a camera to show rashes or injuries. You can join the visit, either in person or on video, to share information or ask questions.

What is the cost?

Telehealth visits are covered by Medicaid and most insurance carriers. You may be asked to provide information regarding your coverage when you enroll. If you do not have insurance, these visits are provided at a sliding scale discount.

How do you enroll your child?
